All university employees, other than those exempt by OIE, have reporting obligation when the employee becomes aware of relationship violence or sexual misconduct allegedly perpetrated by a member of the university community (faculty, staff, or student) or occurring at a university event or on university property, oie.msu.edu/mandatoryreporting.html
