

## POLICY ON PHYSICIAN RECUSAL FROM ACADEMIC SUPERVISION

Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine (MSUCOM) students may seek to establish a provider-patient relationship for medical care with physicians that they know in clinical or academic settings. This may be because of convenience, proximity, familiarity, and/or trust.

While MSUCOM students may seek care from the health professionals of their choosing, once a therapeutic relation is established, the treating physician (or other health professional) must recuse him/herself from:

- 1. Participating in academic or clinical assessment of the student.
- 2. Participating in decisions related to advancement or graduation of the student.
- 3. Participating in MSUCOM committee reviews of the student's academic or professional performance (e.g. COSE).
