## **Policy on Continuum of Medical Education**

SCS is the consortium of MSUCOM training site partners that provides clerkship experiences, graduate medical education and continuing medical education for MSUCOM SCS members. The SCS will bring the resources of MSUCOM and member institutions together to provide exemplary educational experiences for students, residents, fellows, and faculty. SCS member partners in collaboration with MSUCOM will provide curriculum, faculty development, educational technology, osteopathic curriculum, scholarly consultation, and outreach to enhance the quality of training across the continuum of medical education.

- Educational programs under the department of faculty development shall be provided in real time educational programs in person and online to maximize exposure to ACGME requirements and processes. All educational programs will provide AOA CME or ACCME for faculty members participating in faculty development.
- 2. Educational programs and resources are provided for asynchronous access on the SCS website for students, residents and faculty. CME will be provided when appropriate for faculty members.
- SCS will provide faculty presentations and/or consultation across the consortium and the continuum to enhance the educational experience for students, residents, fellows, and faculty.
- 4. MSUCOM and SCS will track all faculty and faculty appointments across the continuum for any educators training students and residents.
- 5. MSUCOM SCS will coordinate the quarterly meetings of MADME (Michigan Association of Directors and Medical Educators) which will provide updates on clerkship education, graduate medical education, and continuing medical education. The committee will report concerns and make recommendations concerning issues across the continuum of medical education to the SCS Governing Board.
