- SDL refers to Self-Directed Learning time, a dedicated time for students to flexibly focus on individual areas of interest/need. Year four summer SDL time is dependent on the block schedule for the class year.

- Clinical Experience refers to a field requirement during the preclerkship. Options and scheduling are flexible, with students engaged one of the indicated times.

- Core rotation schedules are determined by the MSUCOM Office of Clerkship Education. Required rotations include: Family Medicine, Family Medicine Sub-Internship, Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Ambulatory Internal Medicine, Internal Medicine Sub-Internship, Neurology, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Surgery, Pediatrics, & Psychiatry.
